Which do you think is better? Why?

[Response]

They say that you need to spend money to make money. That's true for starting a business, but it also continues to be true throughout the entire lifetime of the business. Companies need to consider how to smartly invest in updating their facilities, and I think the first thing they should do is to develop a better working environment by renovating their work space.

First off, the right work environment can improve communication. Today's companies are complex. They have multiple departments that are all fast-moving and need to constantly interact with each other. Most companies will have teams for products, research and development, programming, marketing, and so on. A proper working space allows each team the privacy to focus on their work, but also allows easy channels for the teams to communicate with each other. If a company's office doesn't allow for this, they should invest in renovation immediately.

Secondly, a comfortable work environment helps employees to work more efficiently. When people are comfortable and free from distractions, they're better able to focus on tasks. For example, I had one class with no temperature control when I was in high school. Even though the teacher was good, I hated
