[Response]

Technology is all around us, all the time. A few decades ago, schools tried to discourage students from using computers or phones, but lately educators have accepted that technology is actually a critical part of every



students' future. Therefore, some people have begun to suggest that schools allow students to use their phones and computers all the time in class. However, I disagree. I believe that schools should limit the use of technology in class.

The main reason I believe this is because it's so important for people to learn social skills while they're still young. I recently read a report in National Geographic that said technology is actually changing our brains; people who spend too much time texting rather than talking actually have lower development in the speech part of the brain. I think that's a horrible tragedy. It is important to learn skills like math, science, and even technology in school, but it's just as important that young students learn how to speak to each other, how to be kind, and how to grow up with manners.

In addition, it's important that students learn how to think for themselves. It's likely that they'll always have access to some sort of computer in the future, but they'll produce better work if they understand how to actually do the work themselves. A great example of this is simple math processes like multiplication and division. When I was young, my teacher had us practice doing this on paper, so I learned to be able to quickly multiply and divide in my mind. However, now I just use my phone's calculator for math all the time, and I find that I'm no longer able to do even simple math in my mind. Schools should have students learn how to solve problems on their own first, and then



allow them later on to solve problems with technology.

Finally, there's nothing lost with restricting the use of technology at school because students will still learn how to use technology when they're at home. Kids these days spend plenty of time on their phones and computers, so they will still grow up being masters of those important tools. I think I'm a pretty good example of how the average student lives, and I spend multiple hours on my phone or computer every day after class. Therefore, there's no reason that I need to also be on my phone while I'm in class.

In the end, technology is important, but it's also important to develop ourselves by putting the technology down for a bit. I believe schools can help students achieve a greater benefit by restricting how much time they spend with technology in class.
