### [Question]

The government should require drivers to pay a fee to be allowed to drive on the city streets during the time when there is the greatest amount of traffic.

## [Response]

Traffic is a problem in almost every major city. Politicians and pundits suggest lots of different ideas to alleviate the issue, but one recent idea is that cities should charge a fee to allow people to drive during rush hour. I think this is a foolish idea and I completely disagree with it.

First off, I believe it is immoral. The government didn't build those roads for free. Instead, they taxed us and used the money from those taxes to build the roads. In other words, we have already paid for the right to drive on the roads and it would be wrong for the government to force us to pay a fee to drive on roads we already paid for. In my city, for example, people might pay



anywhere between 10% and 45% of their pay check in taxes. If there's too much traffic during rush hour, the city should build more roads with the tax money it's taking from us, but they shouldn't force us to pay a fee to drive on the roads we already paid for.

Secondly, I think it's a harmful strategy. The goal of the rush hour fee would be to discourage people from driving at those times, but that would do more harm than good. It helps to put a fee on an activity when it's already a negative activity, like smoking or drinking. However, people driving during rush hour are often doing things that are helpful to the economy. Most of them are going to work, going to shop, or going to meet loved ones. These activities are necessary for our society, and we obviously shouldn't discourage people from doing activities that our society requires them to do.

In the end, I believe I have presented clear arguments for why the government should not implement a fee for driving on the roads during busy hours. I hope they will heed my advice and find a different solution.
