The main reason it's good to read to kids is that it simply builds up their

attention span. Little kids have notoriously short attention spans, and elementary school will require them to study for multiple hours in a day. If a student doesn't have the focus to sit and learn, then they'll be a terrible student, and it doesn't matter how well they can read or do math. Reading to children builds their attention span, and this is a critical skill for success at school.

Another reason that reading aloud to children is that great preparation is that it's sure to cause lots of educational conversations. I volunteered at the local library to read books to elementary students last summer, and it actually took a long time to get through each book because the kids asked so many questions. They wanted to know about the animals in the pictures, about the words they didn't understand, and so much more. It was a lot of fun because every story became an important learning experience. This sort of curiosity and education will go a long way towards helping kids get ready for the first day of school.

Finally, reading aloud to kids is helpful because it can improve their literacy. While the kids may not be the ones reading when they listen to parents tell a story, they're still thinking about the language and understanding how stories work.
